How will this course benefit me?

This course is for parents, carers and grandparents of children in primary schools, children's centres and nurseries who want to support children's learning. You will increase and improve your knowledge and understanding of how and what children learn in literacy lessons at school. You will also have the opportunity to refresh your own literacy skills and knowledge. Adults will learn the basic skills and knowledge that could inspire and enhance career prospects.

What are the entry requirements?

You will need a basic level of English (Entry Level2).

To participate in online courses you will need to have the following:

- a computer/laptop/tablet with a fully updated browser (preferably Google Chrome)
- an email address
- a reliable internet connection
- a microphone and preferably a camera

Once you are enrolled on the course, you will receive detailed instructions on how to join the class

What will I learn?

To develop and improve your

- Knowledge of phonics and the relationship between letters and sounds
- Knowledge of spelling strategies, whilst building confidence with spelling
- Understanding of how children learn to read and write
- Understanding of grammar e.g. nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs
- Understanding of punctuation e.g. full stops, commas, apostrophes and speech marks
- Awareness of some of the features of different text types e.g. explanations, instructions, letters, fiction/ non-fiction
- Understanding of English vocabulary and terms used in school

How will the course be delivered?

This course will be delivered online, and will involve tutor presentation and class discussion. Preparation and homework outside class times is expected/recommended.

How will my learning be assessed?

The tutor will use observation, mark completed tasks, use Q & A and Individual Learning
