How will this course benefit me?

This course is for parents, carers and grandparents of children in primary schools, children's centres and nurseries whose first language is not English. You will have the opportunity to improve your English, develop your confidence, improve your skills, support your children's learning and make a contribution to your community

What are the entry requirements?

To participate in online courses you will need to have the following:

- a microphone and preferably a camera

Once you are enrolled on the course, you will receive detailed instructions on how to join the class

What will I learn?

You will develop your English skills in speaking, listening, reading, writing and grammar for everyday life, including:

- Recognising where you need to improve your language skills and those that could be hindering your ability to support your child/ren with their learning
- Reading a local map to find your child/ren's school and complete school application forms
- Understanding words used by your child/ren's teachers and asking questions about them
- Finding information in a leaflet about making the most of parents' evenings

How will the course be delivered?

This course will be delivered online, and will involve tutor presentation and class discussion. Preparation and homework outside class times is expected/recommended.

How will my learning be assessed?

The tutor will use observation, mark completed tasks, use Q & A and Individual Learning
